

PROJECT INFORMATION

The FDOT proposes to mill and resurface U.S. 98 from the East Pass Bridge to Airport Road. Additional improvements include striping to provide a 4-foot dedicated bike lane, adding an eastbound, right turn lane into HarborWalk Village and an eastbound, left turn lane into the Days Inn / Chick-fil-A shared driveway. Access management modifications will also be constructed between Calhoun Avenue and Palmetto Street.
